The state will remand 25% from each Council to be donated to the Delaware Special Olympics. Councils must name the recipients for the 75% that each Council can award; only charities involved with helping mentally retarded citizens can be designated. The State Secretary will then return checks to Councils for their named charities for Council distribution. These procedures assure compliance with IRS regulations.
